# Service Preparation Sheet: Roaches, Silverfish, Ants and Stored Food Pests

To Whom It May Concern,

<u>Preparation Instructions:</u> YOUR HOME MUST BE COMPLETELY PREPARED FOR PROPER TREATMENT! PLEASE BE RAEDY TO LEAVE YOUR HOME UPON TECHNICIANS ARRIVAL.

### **Vacating Procedures**

- All Persons and Pets <u>MUST</u> be out of treated areas for 2-4 hours! Pregnant Women and Children (under the age of 12 months) must vacate for 8 hours.
- Persons with health problems are advised to consult their Doctor.
- Refer to the Pest Control disclosure for materials to be used list.

**Please note**: Skyline Pest Control <u>cannot</u> move personal items, or service personal items for the control of pests; i.e. televisions, radios, telephones, microwaves, mattresses, answering devices, pictures, furniture, etc,.... Most over-the-counter pesticides may control pest in many personal items. Use caution with electronic items. Pesticides contain petroleum and/or are water based and may cause damage.

#### **Prior To Treatment**

- General Pest (Roaches, Ants, Silverfish, Spiders, Scorpions, Sow bugs, Earwigs & Beetles)
  - 1. Remove all items from areas to be treated; all kitchen cabinets, under sinks etc. <u>all</u> personal items away from these areas. Items can be placed on bed, sofa, or dining table and covered with a sheet.
  - 2. Clean all areas to be treated well with household cleaners and remove any debris.
  - 3. If pests are seen in closets, bathrooms or around baseboards move items 12 inches from the wall where treatment is desired.
  - 4. DO NOT wash cabinets- countertops after treatment is completed.
  - 5. <u>DO NOT</u> use any household sprays or chemicals after treatment (ie. Raid or bleach or Windex). Use dry cloth only or mild soap with warm water on damp towel.
  - 6. Wait 10-14 days for complete results after treatment.

The degree of risks depends upon the degree of exposure, so exposure should be minimized."

"If within 24 hours following application you experience symptoms similar to common seasonal illness comparable to the flu, contact your physician or poison control center (800) 876-4766 and your pest control company immediately."
